its activities About the Trust

CETA GALAXY Charitable Trust is formed with the intention of bringing together all Engineers from College of Engineering Trivandrum under one umbrella and to channelize their expertise and resources for the betterment of our Society especially for the up-liftment of financially challenged sections of Kerala Society. It commenced its operations on 29th July 2011. The activities are of trust is limited only in India. The Trust has obtained registration Under Section 12 AA and Section 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961. Furthermore it has obtained Registration under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010. The trustees of the trust are non—residents and residents of India. It is not engaged in any profit making activities. The document authenticating the trust is the trust deed dated 29th July 2011 and the amended Trust Deed dated 7th November 2014. The Trust's accounts are being maintained and audited in compliance with Article 9 (j) of the Amendments of the Trust Deed dated 7th November 2014.

Activities of the Trust

One of the major activities of this organization is to help students who are financially backward in their education. This activity is termed as HOPE i.e. Helping Outstanding Pupils in Education.

HOPE is an initiative aimed at supporting the academically brilliant but financially challenged students from standard 8th from Government & Aided Schools preferably in the villages of Kerala and to support them to complete 12th standard and beyond successfully to come out as responsible professionals.

The aim of the project is to identify these under-privileged but outstanding children from the wide spectrum of Kerala Society and empower them through a mentoring system to obtain an entry into India's leading professional institutes.

The support and mentoring system also includes helping the students for better academic performance, facilitating higher education and providing information about opportunities in education and career.






HOPE-Helping Outstanding Pupils in Education

The flagship Project of the Trust is HOPE (Helping Outstanding Pupils in Education). HOPE is an initiative aimed at identifying the academically brilliant but financially challenged students from 8th grade in Government & Aided Schools (with minimum 80% marks aggregate in 7th grade) across the villages of Kerala and to support them to complete 12th grade and beyond successfully to come out as responsible professionals.

HOPE Growth over the Years

- During 2011, Started with 30 students from Grade 8.
- During 2015, reaches all 14 districts of Kerala.
- During 2016, 355 students from 200 Schools became beneficiaries of HOPE
- During 2017, 419 students from 14 districts of Kerala became beneficiaries of HOPE



During the FY 2017-18 we have supported 419 studentsunder HOPE spread over all the 14 districts of Kerala and they are planning to extend HOPE scholarship to 1000 students by 2022.



District Level Empowerment Programmes

District level empowerment programmes were conducted in various districts primarily for 11th and 12th grade students to boost their leadership qualities. Another major objective of these sessions was to prepare the plus 2 students to become future volunteers and mentors of HOPE.

The district level empowerments sessions were very much effective particularly for those students, who prepare to join to various professional courses. The programme was organized by the local volunteers and the involvement of parents and senior students in organizing these sessions was commendable.

HOPE CARES

HOPE CARES is a comprehensive programme covering the most backward rural and tribal areas of Kerala with the multipronged approach of financial support, mentoring, hand-holding through higher education and employment support through skill development.

Objectives

- Create Awareness on need for higher education and generate interest on students in tribal/ rural areas to pursue higher education.
- Provide financial support for the most deserving students.
- Equip teachers to motivate students and create awareness among parents

HOPE CARES was formally launched at Agali Govt. High School, Attappadi on 1stOctober'16 with 100 students from 8th grade selected from 3 Govt. tribal schools- Agali, Sholayur and Puthur schools of Attappadi area.

22 selected students were awarded HOPE CARES scholarship. We conducted three training programs during the academic year 2017-18 on 22nd July, 28th October and





16th September at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Agali, Attappadi and at Pudur.

Currently, 180 students from 3 tribal schools in Palakkad district are being supported under this programme out of which 41 deserving students were offered financial support.

HOPE CARES Skill Development Programme

HOPE CARES Skill development programme is aimed at extending job oriented training to school drop outs from the tribal belt. The objective of the programme is to help them find a livelihood by acquiring proficiency in some specialised areas. We have started this programme from Attappadi, Palakkad District Kerala and will spread the same to other tribal areas soon.

In March 2017, the first batch of 30 candidates, who couldn't pursue their higher studies have been selected from Attappadi area and sent them for an intensive skill development program in a ICICI skill development center in Coimbatore. This center provides training in areas like Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Two and Three-wheeler servicing, Pumps and Motors repairs etc.

Training for the next batches where organised at Coimbatore, Agali and Wayanad. The programme is being organised in association with Voltas and being operational in Attappadi (Palakkad District) and Wayanad. Upon the successful completion, around 107 youths from Attappadi and Wayanad have already been placed in various reputed companies in South India.

HOPE PLUS

HOPE PLUS, launched this year is the logical extension of HOPE to support these students for higher education. Under this new scheme, HOPE beneficiaries completing 12th grade with outstanding academic performance will be supported for 5 years to peruse higher education in their area of interest

The most eligible students will be provided financial support (INR 20,000 to INR 60,000 per year) for a maximum period of 5years. During the year 2017, 61 students were awarded HOPE PLUS scholarships. 51 students are being supported by Voltas Ltd and Saint Gobain India Private Ltd supports 10 students.

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a. Basis of preparation of Financial Statements:

The Financial Statements have been prepared under the historical cost conventionin accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India (Indian GAAP) and Accounting Standards. The trust is adopting cash basis of accounting. All assets and liabilities have been classified as current or non-current as per the trust's normal operating cycle. Trust accounts are being maintained and audited in compliance with Article 9 (j) of the Amendments of the Trust Deed dated 7th November 2014.

b. Fixed Assets and Depreciation

The trust does not own any fixed asset. Hence no depreciation has been provided in the books of accounts. A rent-free premise has been provided to the trust by the relative of the treasurer of the trust.

c. Revenue

All the receipts of the trust received during the financial year 2017-18 were revenue receipts. The trust adopts cash basis of accounting. The particulars of receipts received during the period 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2018 has been enclosed below. There was no anonymous donation. All the donations were received for specific purpose.

The receipts of the trust were utilized for its activities like HOPE, HOPE CARE Scholarship payments, HOPE Camps, HOPE District Workshops, HOPE Plus Camp Expenses and other activities that are related to the objective of the trust which amounts to Rs 68.35 lakhs. The trust conducted HOPE camps at Attapadi, Aluva, Kannur, Trivandrum, Malappuram, Kollam, Wayanad, Alappuzha and Thrissur.

It also incurred other expenses like domain renewal fees, website hosting charges, audit fees AGM Expenses, legal and professional charges and other office expenses which amounted to Rs 2.26 lakhs.

e. Excess of Income over Expenditure

The excess of income over expenditure during the financial year 2017-18 amounts to Rs4.07 lakhs.
