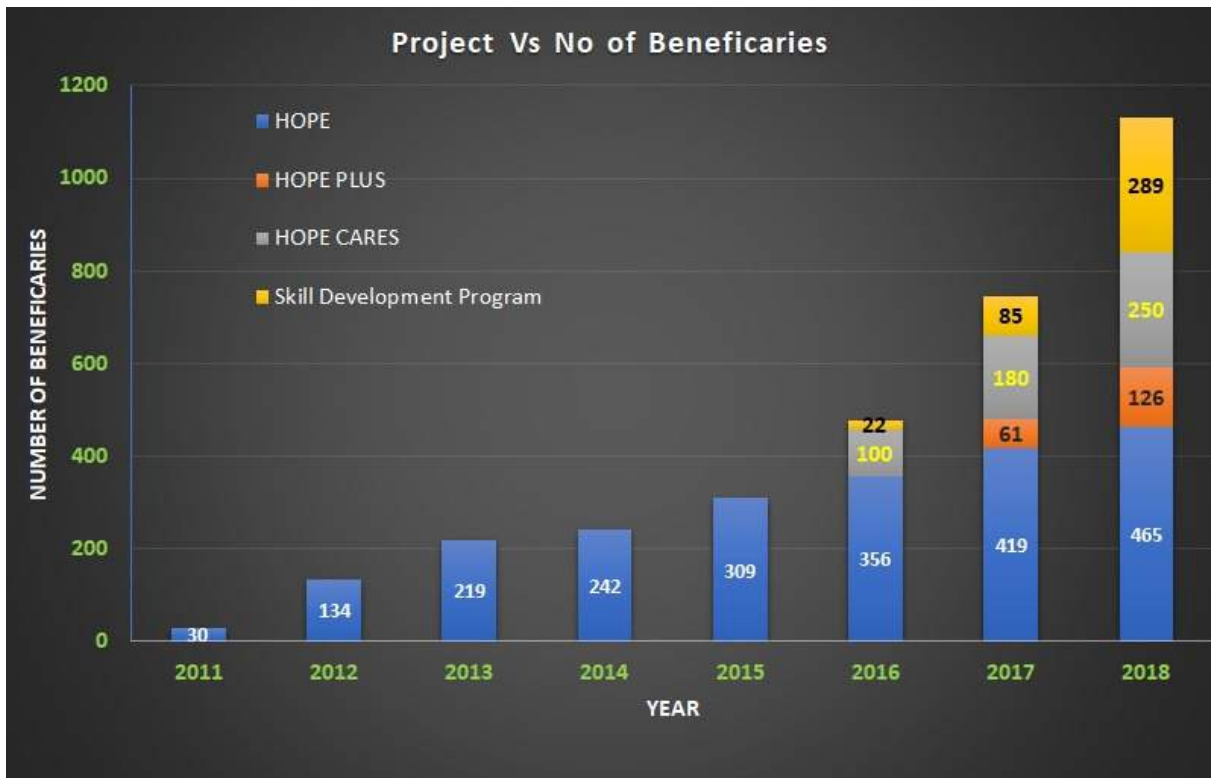

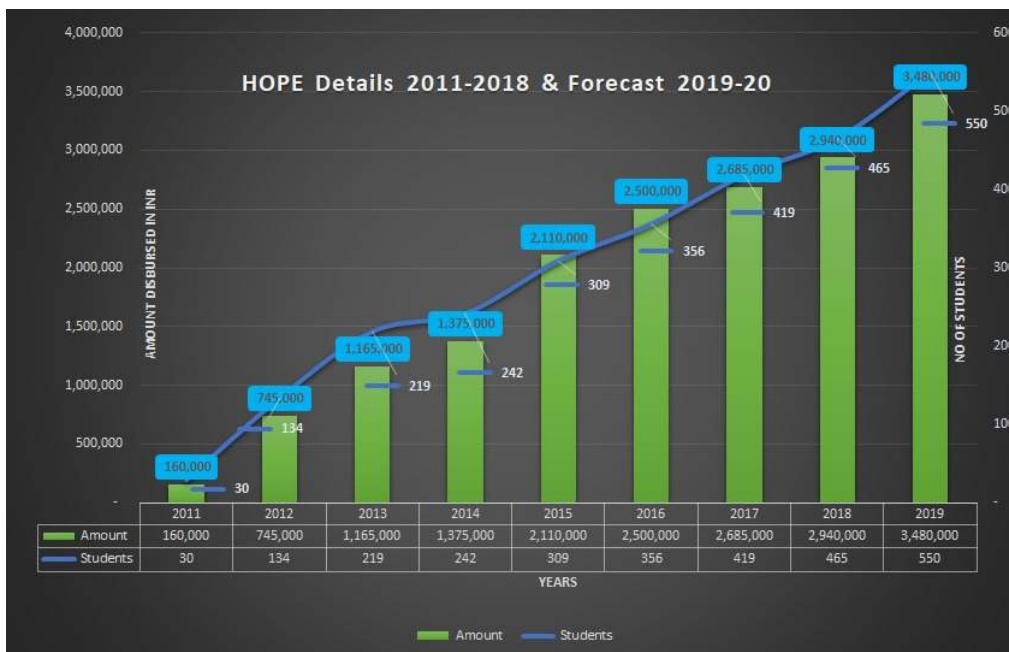

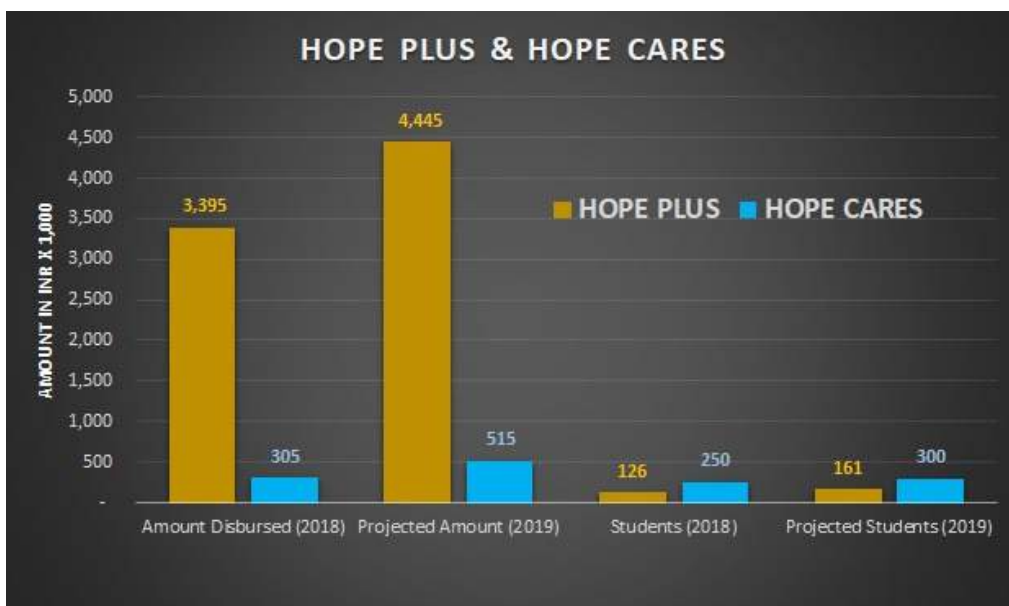

# HOPE State Camp

Around 1100 people, including students and their parents attended the 3 day camp



The activities were formally inaugurated by Mr. T. P. Sen Kumar IPS (former DGP, Govt. of Kerala) along with cine artist Padma Shri Madhu and Dr. C. V. Jiji, Principal, College of Engineering Triuvandrum.



Dr. Alexander Jacob IPS, Dr. V. P. Gangadharan, Psychologist Rev Dr. T. J. Thomas, Mr. Venugopal (Cyber Cell, Kerala Police), Prof. Gangadharan (Kerala Civil Service Academy) and other renowned trainers conducted classes on various topics including Personality Development, Learn to Learn, Cancer Awareness, Stress among students, Cyber Issues and Civil Service Coaching. Insight regarding communication, group discussions, drama and cultural activities were imparted to the students. Also, the HOPE Blood donors forum was formed during the camp.

# HOPE PLUS

**HOPE PLUS**, launched in 2017 is the logical extension of HOPE to support HOPE beneficiaries for higher education. Under this scheme, HOPE beneficiaries who complete their 12th grade with outstanding academic performance will be supported for 5 more years to pursue the higher education in their chosen areas of interest. The most eligible students will be provided financial support (INR 15,000 to INR 60,000 per year) for a maximum period of 5 years. During the year 2018-19, 61 students were awarded HOPE PLUS scholarships. 49 students are being supported by Voltas Ltd and 25 students by Saint Gobain India Pvt Ltd.

## HOPE PLUS Camp

# HOPE CARES

**HOPE CARES** is a comprehensive programme covering the most backward rural and tribal areas of Kerala with a multipronged approach to financial support, mentoring, handholding through higher education and employment support through skill development. Currently, **250 students from 3 tribal schools** in Palakkad district are being supported under this programme out of which **61 deserving students** were offered financial support.

# HOPE CARES

## Skill Development Programme

**HOPE CARES Skill development programme** is aimed at extending job-oriented training to school dropouts from the tribal belt. The objective of the programme is to help them find a livelihood by acquiring proficiency in specialized areas. Selected students are being sent for an intensive skill development training at the ICICI skill development Centre in Coimbatore. The programme is being organised in association with Voltas and is operational in Attappadi (Palakkad District) and Wayanad. Upon successful completion, around **289 youths from Attappadi and Wayanad** have already been placed in various reputed companies in South India.

## REBUILD OF AVITTAM THIRUNAL GOVT. VOCATIONAL HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL

The 'Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony' was at Avittam Thirunal Govt. Vocational Higher Secondary School, Moncompu, Kuttanad, Alappuzha on Friday 1st March 2019 presided by Shri. G. Sudhakaran, Hon. Minister for Public Works, Govt. of Kerala.

The rebuilding activities will be carried out in three phases, the first phase costing INR 89 lakhs includes the construction of additional classrooms, girl's toilet block, RO plant etc. The first phase is fully sponsored by M/s Alfa Laval India Private Limited under their CSR scheme. In addition to the construction works, CGCT will organize regular empowerment sessions to empower students.
